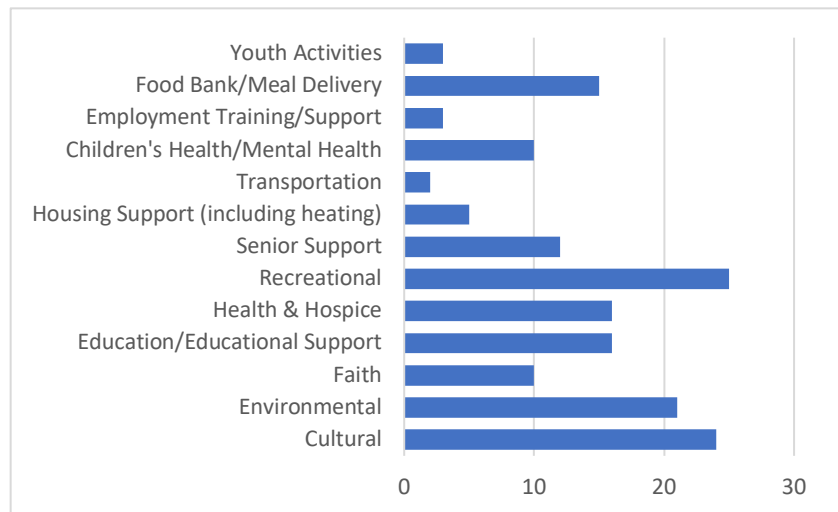


Volunteer Inventory Survey Highlights:

- 38 members responded to the survey – 55% response rate – and 113 volunteer positions were reported; while not a bad response rate, I know that there is a lot more work being done by members who did not respond to the survey
- about half of the respondents said they would be interested in learning about additional volunteer opportunities
- more than three in four reported volunteer positions were current positions
- almost half (45%) of the volunteer positions involved a Board position and most of these were executive positions
- SIRCH, Food Banks, and local Lake Associations were the most frequently reported organizations that were reported by members, but the range was very broad

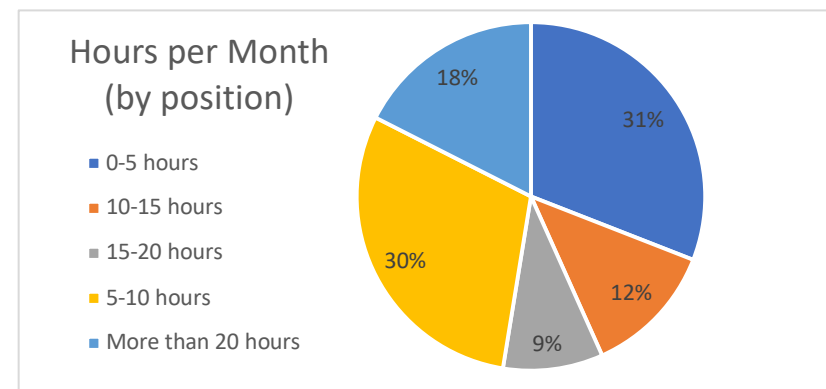
Organizational Mandate

- While volunteer positions in recreation and cultural organizations were most frequently reported, they tended to have smaller time commitments than volunteer positions in organizations with environmental, food security, health and education mandates.



Hours Dedicated to Volunteer Positions

- Members typically (61%) reported that each of their volunteer positions required less than 10 hours per month.
- Based on frequency of report and average in range, members report approximately 13,000 hours



dedicated to on-going volunteer positions each year. In addition, members reported almost 1,000 additional volunteer hours in one-time or project-oriented volunteer positions.
